With reference to your application for Ex gratia, we would like to inform you that the Ex gratia Committee reviewed your application on 20 and 21 October 2016.

Your full application amounted to R193 218.76.

The Ex gratia Committee has partially approved your application and grants you an amount of R17 036.50 in respect thereof.

- Your prospective application for additional Prosthesis limit was declined amounting to R176 182.26:
- Your prospective application for additional Physiotherapy limit was approved in full amounting to R5 108.00;
- Your prospective application for the Speech & Occupational Therapy limit was approved 1 weekly session of Occupational Therapy amounting f to R11 928.50
- An amount of R1 331.50 will be settled subject to your available Speech & Occupational Therapy limit for 2016;
- An amount of R842.00 will be settled subject to your available Physiotherapy limit the Ex gratia approved amount for the Prosthesis.
